
# Nine O'clock in the Morning

Born in poverty in Yorkshire, England. Trained as a plumber; illiterate until his wife taught him to read the Bible early in their marriage. Accepted Jesus and received the Holy Spirit, and was launched into an international evangelistic career that was characterized by signs and wonders. He was known for his weird, unorthodox, controversial methods of praying for people, but the power and efficacy of ministry was legendary.

# Acts 1:8 – God's Plan for You

- <sup>8</sup> but you will receive <u>POWER</u> when the Holy Spirit has come upon you;
- and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

### Two KEY Words

- Power Dunamis
  - power for any thing, even performing miracles
- Witness Martyr
  - Legal term called to tell the truth about what you have seen or heard

The Holy Spirit will give you the ability to tell what you have experienced - with <u>miraculous</u> results!!!!!

### Started With a BANG!

When the day of Pentecost <sup>[a]</sup>had come, they were all together in one place. <sup>2</sup> And suddenly there came from heaven a noise like a violent rushing wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.  $^{3}$  And there appeared to them tongues as of fire <sup>[b]</sup>distributing themselves, and <sup>[c]</sup>they <sup>[d]</sup>rested on each one of them. <sup>4</sup> And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other <sup>[e]</sup>tongues, as the Spirit was giving them <sup>[f]</sup>utterance. <u>*Acts 2 – 1-4*</u>

## Put it all together

When the Holy Spirit comes – really comes – it will be disruptive, unexpected and confusing and uncomfortable at first, but He will empower us to do and say things we wouldn't or couldn't do on our own, AND it will get people's attention, point them to God draw them in, and challenge them to make a choice
