#### As a Result of these Encounters

- <sup>43</sup> [ap] Everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many wonders and [aq]signs were taking place through the apostles. <sup>44</sup>
- And all those who had believed [ar]were together and had all things in common; <sup>45</sup> and they *began* selling their property and possessions and were sharing them with all, as anyone might have need.
- <sup>46</sup> Day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and breaking bread [as]from house to house, they were taking their [at]meals together with gladness and [au]sincerity of heart, <sup>47</sup>
- praising God and having favor with all the people.
- And the Lord was adding [av] to their number day by day those who were being saved.

## The Next Glorious Encounter

<sup>3</sup> When he saw Peter and John about to go into the temple, he *began* asking to receive alms. <sup>4</sup> But Peter, along with John, fixed his gaze on him and said, "Look at us!" <sup>5</sup> And he began to give them his attention, expecting to receive something from them. 6 But Peter said, "I do not possess silver and gold, but what I do have I give to you: In the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene—walk!" <sup>7</sup> And seizing him by the right hand, he raised him up; and immediately his feet and his ankles were strengthened. <sup>8</sup> [c] With a leap he stood upright and *began* to walk; and he entered the temple with them, walking and leaping and praising God.

 Peter realized they had NOTHING to give him that would really help him – it all had to come from JESUS!

## **Close Encounters With HIM!**

<sup>11</sup> While he was clinging to Peter and John, all the people ran together to them at the so-called <sup>[d]</sup>portico of Solomon, full of amazement. <sup>12</sup> But when Peter saw *this*, he replied to the people, "Men of Israel, why are you amazed at this, or why do you gaze at us, as if by our own power or piety we had made him walk? <sup>13</sup> The **God** of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified His [e]servant Jesus, ......<sup>16</sup> And on the basis of *faith in His name, it is* [9]the name of Jesus which has strengthened this man whom you see and know; and the faith which comes through Him has given him this perfect health in the presence of you all.

## **Our Differentiator**

- In business, when we say "the competition" what are we talking about?
- So, the Church has competition, too. Let's name some:
- What is it that should make the Church different than all of our competitors?
- The one thing that differentiates the church from the world, ALL we really have to give, is a connection to the life-changing power and presence of God

#### Close Encounters=Holy Double Take

- <sup>9</sup> And all the people saw him walking and praising God; <sup>10</sup> and they were taking note of him as being the one who used to sit at the Beautiful Gate of the temple to *beg* alms, and they were filled with wonder and amazement at what had happened to him.
- Consternation and Confusion
- They witnessed the unexpected, the impossible, the unexplainable
- Well, there is an explanation, but it is crazy

# Paul's Simple Strategy

And when I came to you, brethren, **I did not** come with superiority of speech or of **wisdom,** proclaiming to you the <sup>[a]</sup>testimony of God. <sup>2</sup> For I determined to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified. <sup>3</sup> I was with you in weakness and in fear and in much trembling, <sup>4</sup> and my <sup>[b]</sup>message and my preaching were not in persuasive words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, <sup>5</sup> so that your faith would not [c]rest on the wisdom of men, *but on the* power of God.

#### All we have is Jesus

- And that is enough
- That is what people really need
- Not programs but life
- Not "relevance" but relationship with Him and with His body – where they can be loved and healed and restored
- But it is not about US, it is about his power flowing through us and using us as we share the only thing that really matters

- <sup>42</sup> They were continually devoting themselves to:
  - the apostles' teaching firm foundation
  - and to fellowship connectedness with each other – where love and power flows
  - to the breaking of bread remembering Him who is our hope and our source
  - and to prayer. participating power, love and presence of God ignites it all

# It is Just This Simple

The Body of Christ – that's you and me and every place and every person where the Name of Jesus is lifted up - should be a place where people **ENCOUNTER HIM** – His love and His power and His grace and His lifechanging presence. It can happen in a thousand ways, but if it is NOT happening, we are NOT the Body of Christ – we are NOT His Church.

Because we have nothing else to offer anyone, but the chance to know HIM
