



### Wake-Up Call



## Acts 5:1-11

- But a man named Ananias, with his wife Sapphira, sold a piece of property, <sup>2</sup> and kept back some of the price for himself, with his wife's [a]full knowledge, and bringing a portion of it, he laid it at the apostles' feet.
- It was a lie God revealed it to be a lie, and they both died that day
- Why did they do what they did? Because they didn't understand the Gospel
- Why did God do what he did? To protect the integrity of the early church

#### The Rest of the Story

12 [f] At the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were taking place among the people; and they were all with one accord in Solomon's portico. 13 But none of the rest dared to associate with them; however, the people held them in high esteem. 14 And all the more believers in the Lord, multitudes of men and women, were constantly added to their number, 15 to such an extent that they even carried the sick out into the streets and laid them on cots and pallets, so that when Peter came by at least his shadow might fall on any one of them. 16 Also the [9] people from the cities in the vicinity of Jerusalem were coming together, bringing people who were sick hor afflicted with unclean spirits, and they were all being healed.
