

I Saw the Lord



Romans 5: 1-5

Therefore, having been justified by faith, [a] we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ² through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and [b] we exult in hope of the glory of God. ³ And not only this, but [c] we also exult in our tribulations, knowing that tribulation brings about perseverance; ⁴ and perseverance, proven character; and proven character, hope; 5 and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

What is Eternal Life?

- John 17:3 This is eternal life: that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
- Eternal Life is a Real-time, Lovebased, Interactive, Transformative Relationship with Jesus
- How do we get there?

Worship - Isaiah 6: 1-4 - Awareness

The Lord sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple.

² Seraphim stood above Him, each having six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.

³ And one called out to another and said,

"Holy, Holy, Holy, is the LORD of hosts, The [a] whole earth is full of His glory."

⁴ And the ^[b]foundations of the thresholds trembled at the voice of him who called out, while the ^[c]temple was filling with smoke.



Isaiah 6: 5 - Conviction of Need

⁵ Then I said,

"Woe is me, for I am ruined! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I live among a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts."

Isaiah 6: 6-7 - Restoration

⁶ Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a burning coal in his hand, which he had taken from the altar with tongs. ⁷ He touched my mouth *with it* and said,

"Behold, this has touched your lips; and your iniquity is taken away and your sin is [d] forgiven."

Isaiah 6: 8 - Surrender

Then I heard the voice of the Lord, saying,

"Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?"

Then I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

 The Isaiah Pattern: Awareness, Conviction, Restoration, Surrender

How Do We Get There? Worship.

- Worship is Not an Event (i.e., worship service at 11:00 am)
- It is an ENCOUNTER with God
- Worship is Not the warm-up to the main event (the sermon)
- Sometimes, when the sermon releases revelation under the anointing of the Holy Spirit, it can inspire a worship event to occur in our hearts. OR ... it can just be boringly irrelevant.
- Our process:
 - Praise (Psalm 22:3 "God inhabits the praises of His People"),
 - Leads us into His Presence,
 - which can trigger the Isaiah Pattern of Awareness, Conviction, Restoration, Surrender
