

## Just the Facts

- 50% of people in the US <u>could</u> become infected
- 50% of those infected will have NO symptoms, but still be carriers
- The virus is NOT airborne, you can only be infected by coming into direct contact with the virus, usually by touching someone or something that is carrying the virus
- Aggressive handwashing, wiping down surfaces, and social distancing – including staying home – is enough to keep most people completely safe
- There will soon by drive-by testing stations at Wal-Mart to get tested if you have respiratory symptoms
- So far, only 1% of the people who are tested turn out to have the virus

- No cases so far
- Burnet County Disaster Management team and local health officer are monitoring the situation closely
- Highland Lakes Crisis Network has a seat on that team, and we get updates immediately when anything changes
- Local pastors met on Friday to discuss a unified response, and determined we would keep holding services until we get word from Kevin that the situation has changed.
- When it changes, we will decide as a group when to postpone services
- Tentative plans for an open-air community prayer service
- If schools close, we may need volunteers to distribute meals and provide other support as needed
