Expect the Unexpected

- Jeremiah 33:3 "Call on Me and I will show you Great and Mighty things you DID NOT KNOW"
- We need to hear from God and be led by the Holy Spirit.
- Don't start with a list of possibilities we could or should do.
- Start with a blank slate, "Holy Spirit, Give us direction and understanding
- Listen to HIM, and Expect the unexpected.

Do You Listen to Him?

- We spend a lot of time trying to <u>get Him to</u> <u>listen to US!</u> How do you listen to Him?
- Intention Do you intend to listen to Him? Do you <u>earnestly desire to hear His voice?</u>
- Expectation Do you expect Him to speak to you? Are you ready to hear from Him?
- Recognition "My sheep hear my voice." But we don't always notice because we are not practiced listeners. Maybe a "rhema" experience. Maybe just a phrase or a song or a picture. But you sense it is important.

Because: Rethinking Church 80%

of the time, talent and resources of a local church is spent on care, feeding and maintenance members, equipment and buildings

Only 20%

is invested in ministry/outreach in the local community in a way that would connect new people to Jesus, transform culture, and extend His Kingdom

Thy Kingdom Come ...

- Wherever Jesus went, people were helped, healed and set free. He was out in the world, where the need was greatest.
- We are His body today, and how do we spend our time?
- The Church has focused too long on inside the church building where we are comfortable.
- Begins with wanting His will instead of ours.
- Things will not change until we learn to talk less and listen more.

Happy Meal – Kingdom Power

⁵ Therefore Jesus, lifting up His eyes and seeing that a large crowd was coming to Him, *said to Philip, "Where are we to buy bread, so that these may eat?" ⁶ This He was saying to test him, for He Himself knew what He was intending to do. ⁷ Philip answered Him, "Two hundred [b]denarii worth of bread is not **sufficient for them** [he had a budget], for everyone to receive a little." - John 6

Never Tell Jesus the Odds

⁸One of His disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, *said to Him, ⁹ "There is a lad here who has a Happy Meal - five barley loaves [pancakes] and two fish [sardine-ish], but what are these for so many people?" ¹⁰ Jesus said, [never tell me the odds!7 "Have the people [c]sit down." So the men ^[d]sat down, in number about five thousand.

The Rest is History

A Matter of Perspective

We ALWAYS start by looking at the <u>size</u> of the <u>problem</u>

- Then we assess our HUMAN capabilities
- Then we ask Jesus to bless what we think is <u>Humanly possible – just dumb</u>
- Or we just assume it is **NOT POSSIBLE!!**
- We must keep reminding ourselves that with God <u>ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE!!</u>
- Put our Happy Meal in His Hands, then listen for His Voice and Follow Him
