A Story About Stories

Once Upon A Time

- Sum up the teaching style of Jesus in one word
- Parables Jesus taught timeless, lifechanging spiritual truth using stories
- The only time he got into matters of detailed doctrine was when the Jews wanted to argue
- Even then, he often framed His answer in stories like

Why Do You Suppose He Did This

- Because our brain LOVES stories, our brain is much more fully engaged with a story than with an algebra problem
- Our brain remembers things we learn from stories better than things we learn from lectures or reading tables of figures.
- Our brains love watching stories unfold movies or books or athletics – and we love happy endings. We crave happy endings as assurance that ultimately we can be safe.

As A Matter of Fact

- Our brain consciously or unconsciously can only make decisions after it converts them into a story.
- You may think you make your decision after doing lots of research and analysis based on facts and logic that take place in the analytical left side of your brain
- But at the very last minute, your brain shoves all of that data to the emotional right side and says, "So, how do I feel about this? Will this give me my happy ending?

The Hero's Journey



Joseph Campbell

- Hard-wired in the thinking of all human cultures.
- A central character <u>who</u> <u>is not enough</u> (Hero)
- Reluctantly drawn into a situation
- Faces challenges, discovers resources
- Perseveres through it all
- Finally achieves the happy ending
- It's everywhere

You Are Living Your Story

- Shouldn't be surprised, then, to learn your brain sees every aspect of your life as a chapter in your own Hero's journey.
 - You often feel like you are not enough
 - You almost always have to deal with "stuff" even though you don't want to
 - You encounter obstacles while you are trying to find solutions
 - Working, hoping, praying to find that happy ending so you can take a breath and rest, feeling safe and at peace once again.

And The Story Goes On and On

- You can categorize most events in your life as somehow relating to your personal Hero's journey, searching for the next happy ending to solve whatever problem is facing you so that you can feel safe and rest
- A couple of weeks ago I was discussing the details and challenges of my life with God, explaining to Him how tired I was and how much I needed a breakthrough to fix things

And I Heard Him Clearly Say..

- You are struggling because you are confused
- You have things completely backwards

You are NOT the Hero in this story, and it is NOT your job to fix anything or find the happy ending here

Greatest Story Ever Told

- I AM THE HERO IN YOUR STORY
- I HAVE ALWAYS BEEN YOUR HERO
- I HAVE ALWAYS BEEN WORKING IN YOUR LIFE
- AND I WILL BRING YOU TO THE HAPPY ENDING YOUR HEART HUNGERS FOR
- AT THIS MOMENT I AM REWIRING YOUR BRAIN TO SEE YOUR LIFE AS <u>MY STORY</u>, THE STORY OF <u>MY LIFE BEING LIVED</u> <u>THROUGH YOU</u>

And Then I Saw My Hero

- Revealed in Revelation 19:11-16
- In 11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war. 12 His eyes are a flame of fire, and on His head are many diadems; and He has a name written on Him which no one knows except Himself. ¹³ He is clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God.
