




A Moment of Silence


- First, to honor the loss of 164,000,000 aborted children since the 1973 Roe v Wade decision in 1973, and briefly contemplate the impact of that loss on America


Friday Was a Glory Day

- It is right and good to celebrate and give thanks for this momentous victory.....




Now, What's Next?

- As a Church and as a Nation, we have now entered an even more complex Culture war and an even more urgent Caring Mission.




Let's Survey The Landscape

- Dobbs did NOT make abortion illegal in America. It only overturned the 1973 Roe decision that declared the right to abortion to be protected by the 14th Amendment of the Constitution.
- The debate is now returned to the states, where each state gets to make its own laws about abortion.
- The most likely outcome is that over half of the states will keep abortion legal, and in some cases make it legal deep into the third trimester, something not even Roe allowed.




Warning: Legal Jargon Here

- Also, through this decision, the Supreme Court pretty much blew up a major 700-year old legal doctrine known as **stare decisis** – the principle of legal precedent that says if a previous court has already ruled on a matter, it is settled in the law.
- By overturning Roe, the court significantly weakened this principle so that a future – liberal – court, could come back and reverse this decision and declare that abortion is protected by the Constitution after all




Culture War Drives Politics

- Pro-abortion advocates are clinging to one ace in the hole that could make Dobbs moot
- At any time in the future, if pro-abortion forces gain clear control of the House, the Senate and the White House (Obama first term) they could pass a federal law legalizing abortion nationwide and a conservative SCOTUS could not overturn it.
- Even in Texas, DAs in some counties are vowing not to prosecute abortion providers, which will at least slow down enforcement.




We Won A Big Battle, But ...

- The main thing it accomplished was for the Texas legislature, and other like-minded legislatures, to protect unborn children by severely limiting access to abortion in their state. That is a big deal! (one election cycle)
- And women who have resources can still go to New Mexico or some other state, and some businesses will even provide a new “health benefit” to cover 100% of that cost for their employees.
- And that brings us to the Caring Mission.




Unto the Least of These

- Women on the lower socio-economic scale sometimes feel trapped by unplanned pregnancies and many, out of desperation, chose abortion as a solution. Not defending that choice by any means, but it is not going to be there in Texas now.
- Which means that even more women with no income and no family support and no baby daddy support are going to be in desperate need of mercy and grace for themselves and their kids.



The System is Broken

- Social service agencies in Texas are already starting to panic, because they know there aren't enough resources to care for the tidal wave of new clients that are coming. They are wrong to think that abortion was the right answer, but they are not wrong that the situation is about to get more difficult.
- At HLCN we are starting to understand that the needs we are seeing with homelessness and the foster care system and hunger and poverty have a commonality – single moms with no skills and no means of support.




Dobbs Doesn't Help

- It doesn't do anything to provide single moms, broken families, and kids abandoned in foster care (abortion in slow motion) with the help and the hope and the love they need. A new wave is coming.
- Doesn't provide adequate housing or daycare or healing from addiction or good nutrition or life skills training or family counseling or adoption services or a transformational relationship with Jesus, who is the source of true help and healing.




The Local Church (US) Is

- This Caring mission will not only deliver our neighbors from generational cycle of suffering, it will provide the most powerful means of introducing them to Jesus




What If the Church Rose Up?

- “You know the Kingdom of God has arrived when systemic poverty is overcome.” Ed Silvoso




The Situation Has Changed

- For now, I know we are called to pray and get ready.




This is the Great Commandment
