

This May Come As News ...

- ¹ Corinthians 6:19</sup> Or do you not know that your body is a [a]temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from [b]God, <u>and</u> <u>that you are not your own?</u> ²⁰ For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.
- When you gave your life to Jesus, did anyone say to you, "Welcome to the Body of Christ. You are now a Part of HIM and you longer have the right to control your own life?"

The Church is Jesus!!

Colossians 1:18 He is also head of the <u>body</u>, <u>the church</u>; and He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that He Himself will come to have first place in everything.

Now I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake, and in my flesh I [ag]do my share on behalf of <u>His body</u>, **Which is the church**, in filling up what is lacking [ah]in Christ's afflictions.

Living Stones in His Temple

1 Peter 2:4 And coming to Him as to a living stone which has been rejected by men, but is ^[]choice and precious in the sight of God, ⁵ you also, as living **stones**, ^[j]are being built up as a **spiritual house** for a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual **sacrifices** acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

And Then it Hit Me

The church is HIS body and HIS temple His Plan –our destiny– is for His life and His glory to dwell in us and be revealed, released and expressed through **US** to the whole world. But if the Body is not united, His temple is in ruins, and His Kingdom cannot come on the earth What I saw: The ground littered with body parts, like from some slasher movie, and the landscape covered in bricks and blocks and shattered columns and broken friezes because there is no unity or shared vision for the Body of Christ on earth

How much does this resemble any experience of the church you have ever encountered?


Safety in Community

Safety in Community

Hebrews 3:12 Take care, brethren, that there not be in any one of you an evil, unbelieving heart that falls away from the living God.

- ¹³ But encourage one another day after day, as long as it is still called "Today," so that none of you will be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.
- If daily encouragement was so urgent in 60 AD, in that much simpler culture, HOW MUCH MORE URGENT MUST IT BE TODAY with all the temptations and distractions we face?

Hold On To Each Other

- Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful;
- ²⁴ and <u>let us consider how to stimulate</u> one another to love and good deeds,
- ²⁵ not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more as you see the day drawing near.

The Road Goes On Forever

- ICol 3:12 So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved,
- put on a heart of compassion, kindness humility, gentleness and ^[k]patience;
- ¹³ bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you. ¹⁴ Beyond all these things <u>put on love, which is [1]the</u> perfect bond of unity.

¹⁵ Let the peace of Christ ^[m]rule in your hearts, to which ^[n]indeed you were called in one body; and ^[0]be thankful. ¹⁶ Let the word of ^[p]Christ richly dwell within you, ^[q]with all wisdom teaching and **admonishing** [r]one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing ^[s] with thankfulness in your hearts to God. ¹⁷ Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.
