


ARISTIDES OF ATHENS B? – D 134 AD

To Be Very Clear

- This doesn't say, "behold how they love one another, every Sunday morning from 10:30 AM to noon."
- This kind of community impact and widespread notoriety could only happen as they shared life together at a deeply committed level every day, day after day. But Why? How?
 It was a <u>different kind of love!</u>

Francis Chan Letters to the Church

As elders we came to the painful conclusion that when unbelievers came to our services, they weren't observing anything supernatural about the way we loved one another.

What does that really mean?

Original Church Brand Acts 2

⁴² They were <u>continually devoting themselves</u> to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and [ao] to prayer. ⁴³ [ap] Everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many wonders and [aq]signs were taking place through the apostles. 44 And all those who had believed were together and had all things in common; 45 and they began selling their property and possessions and were sharing them with all, as anyone might have need.

Life Together

⁴⁶ Day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and breaking bread from **house** to house, they were taking their ^[at]meals together with gladness and [au] sincerity of heart, 47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord was adding ^[av]to their number day by day those who were being saved. What is going on here???

Let Me Remind You...

- So, when you "get saved," you <u>don't</u> become a saved but still <u>individual</u> free moral agent, still independent but now better equipped to live your life with more blessings throughout eternity
- NO, no, no, no ... when we are born again and <u>the Holy Spirit takes residence within us</u>, it is for the **express purpose of becoming a part of HIS BODY**, filled with **His life** and gifted with supernatural abilities **from Him** so <u>He can LOVE the world through us</u>

Paul Painted Us A Picture

Philippians 2: Therefore, if there is any encouragement in Christ, if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of the Spirit, if any ^[a]affection and compassion, ² make my joy **complete** ^[b]by being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose. [which is?]

³ Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves;

Servanthood as Purpose

- ⁴ do not *merely* look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.
- ⁵ Have this attitude ^[e]in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, ⁶ who, although He existed in the form of God, <u>did not</u> <u>regard equality with God a thing to be</u> <u>grasped</u> ⁷ but ^[g]emptied Himself, taking the form of a <u>bond-servant</u>, and being made in the likeness of men.

Humility is True Love

- ⁸ Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death [h]on a cross.
- ⁹ For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, ¹⁰ so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father

Verse 9 Is NOT the Point

- When is the last time you were loved like this by someone else?
- Have you ever been loved like this by someone else?
- When was the last time YOU loved someone else live this?
- Have you EVER loved someone else like this?

Refresh Your Memory

- Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit
- Humbly regard others as more important than yourself
- Not protecting your own personal interests, but also protecting the interests of others (whether you like them or not)
- Relinquishing your own rights to sacrificially serve others
- Humbling yourself to become obedient to Him, even if the cost seems too great
- AS A WAY OF LIFE

¹² So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your salvation with fear and trembling; ¹³ for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for *His* good pleasure.
