# Psalm 46: Be still and know that **I am God**. Stop striving, stressing, struggling, agitating, and surrender to me

# Promise of Isaiah 30:15

- For thus the Lord <sup>[p]</sup>GOD, the Holy One of Israel, has said, "In repentance and rest <u>you will be saved</u>, In quietness and trust <u>is your</u> strength."
- But you were not willing
- Sin is anything that keeps us from fulling trusting in Jesus

# Then I Ended Up Here

- Matthew 11:28 "Come to Me, all <sup>[Z]</sup>who are weary and heavy-laden, and <u>I will give</u> you rest.
- <sup>29</sup> Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and YOU WILL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS.
- So For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

#### **Simple Question**

# Lord, what does your yoke look like? What is it?

- Simple Answer You have studying it this whole time:
- It is TRUST which binds you to me, and surrenders control to me, and allows me to guide and carry you

# It Is Just That Simple

- Our life in Christ Jesus is not burdensome, it is not pulling a heavy load, not do-better-tryharder
- It is not pulling a load at all
- It is not sharing a load with Jesus,
