Changing My Mind (Repent)

- **12** Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to **present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, [a]acceptable to God, *which is your [b]spiritual service of worship.*** ² **And do not be conformed to this [c]world,** but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may **[d]prove what the will of God is,** that which is good and **[e]acceptable and perfect.**



Thinking of Others

- ³ For through the grace given to me **I say to everyone among you not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think; but to think so as to have sound judgment, as God has allotted to each a measure of faith.**



Using All the Gifts

⁴ For just as we have many members in one body and all the members do not have the same function, ⁵ **so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another.** ⁶ Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, *each of us is to exercise them accordingly*: if prophecy, [**f**]according to the proportion of his faith; ⁷ if [**g**]service, in his serving; or he who teaches, in his teaching; ⁸ or he who exhorts, in his exhortation; he who gives, with [**h**]liberality; he who [**i**]leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.



Leading With Love

- **⁹ *Let love be without hypocrisy.***
- **Abhor** what is evil; **cling** to what is good. **¹⁰ *Be devoted*** to one another in brotherly love; **[i]**give **preference** to one another in honor; **¹¹** not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; **¹²** rejoicing in hope, persevering in tribulation, **devoted to prayer** **¹³ contributing to the needs** of the **[k]**saints, **practicing hospitality.**



Elevate Others

- 14 Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. 15 **Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep.** 16 Be of the same mind toward one another; do not be **haughty** in mind, but **associate with the lowly**. Do not be wise in your own estimation. 17 Never pay back evil for evil to anyone. Respect what is right in the sight of all men.



Forgiveness and Mercy

- **18 If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men.** 19 Never take your own revenge, beloved, but leave room for the wrath of God, for it is written, “Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,” says the Lord. 20 “But if your enemy is hungry, feed him, and if he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in so doing you will heap burning coals on his head.” 21 **Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.**

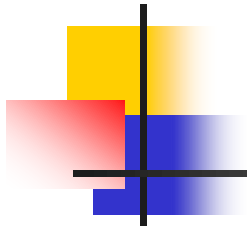
