Keeps Getting Better!

- **Colossians 1:21** And although you were formerly alienated and hostile in mind engaged in evil deeds, ²² yet He has now **reconciled** you in His fleshly body through death, in order to **present you before Him**
- **holy and blameless and beyond reproach—**
- ²³ if indeed you continue in [ad]the faith firmly established and steadfast, and not moved away from the **hope of the gospel**



One Caveat

- This promise doesn't mean there aren't lots of people in the world who don't see you this way, and who won't treat you with disdain and disrespect and bitterness and rudeness and criticism and condemnation
- But because God officially CERTIFIES that you are HOLY, BLAMELESS and BEYOND REPROACH, you are promised – Guaranteed His love, mercy, faithfulness and the fullness of His presence, to sustain and deliver you no matter what they say/do – FEAR NOT!!!
