History of Advent

- Latin adventus translation of Gk "Parousia" which means the coming or arrival, often of a great ruler returning from victory
- Originally had NOTHING to do with the birth of Jesus
- First associated (380 AD)with getting candidates prepared for baptism after 3 years of instruction and 40 days of fasting leading up to December 25
- By 600 AD, church adopted it as a time of fasting and prayer for everyone

But Check This Out

- The emphasis was primarily on praying for, looking forward to, and getting ready for the SECOND COMING OF JESUS when He will bring in His Kingdom
- There was also an emphasis on the coming of Christ into the believer's life
- Not until 1000 AD do we see any evidence on the birth of Jesus, primarily toward the end of the fast days
- Advent was about fasting and preparation until well into the Middle Ages

At Which Point ...

- It became more about parties and feasting and occasionally gift giving from the end of November all the way through January 6
- People were still required to go to church and observe the rituals, but the shift from the second coming to the first coming made it easier to transform it into a set of holidays instead of Holy Days
- And starting on December 25, all the fasting and penitence was over and it became 12 days of often outrageous consumption

I Am Not the Grinch!

- I don't think it is wrong to celebrate Christmas ... wonderful and beautiful way to honor Jesus, love others, and bless families
- But I do think it is deeply troubling that the original purpose of Advent has been lost to the ages, because it was and still is profoundly important
- Recovering this focus would be transformative!

Look At Four Passages

- 2 Timothy 4:7-8 ⁷ I have fought the good fight, I have finished the course, I have kept the faith; ⁸ in the future there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day; and not only to me, but also to all who have loved His appearing.
- Not His first appearing, but His SECOND
- Hoping and Yearning and Waiting for His return

Purifying Hope

1 John 3: 1-3 - See ^[a]how great a love the Father has bestowed on us, that we would be called children of God; and *such* we are. For this reason the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.² Beloved, **now** we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is. ³ And everyone who has this hope fixed on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure. (????)
