...Do not be grieved, for the JOY of the Lord is your strength.



Our ultimate motive in fellowship is to deepen and strengthen relationships. Seeing joy in others and allowing joy to shine out from ourselves connects us and pleases God.


Joy in a discipler adds authenticity to delivery of God's message.

- Conscious thought
- Speech
- Strategies
- Problem solving
- Logic
- Stories

### **RIGHT (FAST TRACK)**

- Individual identity
- Group identity
- Emotional attunement to others
- · Assessment of surroundings (good, bad, scary)
- Relational attachments
