Hebrews 12

1 Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding **us**, let **us** also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles **us**, and let **us** run with endurance the race that is set before **us**,

2 fixing **our** eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the **joy** set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

3 For consider Him who has endured such hostility by sinners against Himself, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.

4 You have not yet resisted to the point of shedding blood in your striving against sin;

5 and you have forgotten the exhortation which is addressed to you as **sons**,
“My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord,
Nor faint when you are reproved by Him;

6 For those whom the Lord loves He **disciplines**,
And He scourges every son whom He receives.

7 It is for discipline that you endure; **God deals with you as with sons**; for what son is there whom *his* father does not discipline?

Probably not the way of the Pharisees:

John 8

3 The scribes and the Pharisees *brought a woman caught in adultery, and having set her in the center of the court, 4 they *said to Him, "Teacher, this woman has been caught in adultery, in the very act. 5 Now in the Law Moses commanded us to stone such women; what then do You say?" 6 They were saying this, testing Him, so that they might have grounds for accusing Him

God's primary goal for you is not to make you healthy, wealthy, or happy, but to make you Christ-like.

"Go and sin no more"

Hebrew "sin" = to stray. To go away from God.

Greek (N.T.) = to miss the mark

How do I go about admonishing someone?

How Matthew 18: 15 "If your brother sins, go and show him his fault in private; if he listens to you, you have won your brother. **16** But if he does not listen to *you*, take one or two more with you, so that by the mouth of two or three witnesses every fact may be confirmed. **17** If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector.

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

Colossians 3:16

And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence to the full assurance of hope until the end, that you do not become sluggish, but imitate those who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

Hebrews 6: 11-12

...not the way of the Corinthians:

1 Corinthians 6:

6 Does any one of you, when he has a case against his neighbor, dare to **go to law before the unrighteous and not before the saints?**

2 Or do you not know that the saints will judge the world? If the world is judged by you, are you not competent *to constitute* the smallest law courts? **3** Do you not know that we will judge angels? How much more matters of this life?

4 So if you have law courts dealing with matters of this life, do you appoint them as judges who are of no account in the church?

5 I say *this* to your shame. *Is it so, that* there is not among you one wise man who will be able to decide between his brethren, **6** but brother goes to law with brother, and that before unbelievers?

7 Actually, then, it is already a defeat for you, that **you have lawsuits with one another.**

Why not rather be wronged? Why not rather be defrauded? **8** On the contrary, you yourselves wrong and defraud. *You do this even to your brethren.*
