


God's true way of help is the inward way of spirit touching spirit.


Meekness must issue from the work of the Holy Spirit, for He alone knows our need


and will arrange circumstances leading to the breaking of our outward man.


Humility

(from Phillipians 2)

- Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,

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

So how do we become meek?




For the good that I want,
